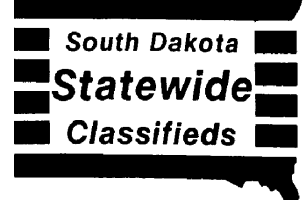

not the validity of using public funds for campaign financing. But that didn't stop Bruning from seeking to have all of Nebraska's campaign finance law thrown out, arguing that the law's public funding trigger "is not severable" from the rest of the law. Therefore, he argued, "the entire act must be found unconstitutional."

Defenders of the Nebraska law responded that the law is a legitimate way to combat political corruption. Lincoln attorney Jeffrey Patterson, argued to preserve the law, stating in a brief before the state Supreme Court that the law provides for more, not less, political speech by encouraging a candidate's communication with the electorate and freeing the candidate from the pressures of fundraising.

The state attorney general "has not made a sufficient case that no set of circumstances exists under which the (state law) would be valid," Patterson said in his brief. "To the contrary, it is clearly constitutionally permissible to encourage voluntary participation in a scheme to limit campaign expenditures, even if the scheme includes an inducement of access to public funding to make voluntary participation the rational choice."

Government watchdog group Common Cause Nebraska and the League of Women Voters jointly filed a brief in support of the state's campaign finance law.
