

USD's Mettler Wins 5,000 In School Record Time

LINCOLN, Neb. — Jeff Mettler set a new USD record while winning the men's 5,000-meter in 14:08.74 at the Frank Sevigne Invitational on Friday.

Mettler broke the record of 14:18.37 set by Matt Hoyt in 2000, and recorded the ninth-best time in Division I this season. Teammate Ethan Marquardt finished fifth with a time 15:05.33.

In the men's pole vault, Kyle Ballew placed second with a mark of 17-1¼. That mark upped his best height this season by an inch and places him 23rd on the national performance list.

Peter Chapman placed ninth in the same event with a height of 16-2.

Two other Coyotes placed in the top 10 on Friday. Christian Nielsen placed ninth in the 400 in 49.95 and Jeff O'Connell placed 10th in the long jump with a mark of 22-5.

The meet continues today (Saturday) at 10 a.m.

LINCOLN, Neb. — Nebraska 174-pounder Robert Kokesh extended his win streak to 22 with a 19-3 techni-

cal fall over Michigan State's Jordan Wolfert during The Cornhuskers' 23-19 victory over the Spartans in Big Ten wrestling action on Friday.

Kokesh, a sophomore from Yankton, improved to 27-1 overall and 13-1 in dual competition. The third-ranked wrestler in the nation by InterMat, Kokesh scored his fifth technical fall victory of the season.

Nebraska improved to 10-4 overall, 4-3 in the Big Ten, with the victory. Michigan State fell to 4-10 and 0-6.

Bulls G Hinrich To Have Right Elbow Examined

NEW YORK (AP) — Guard Kirk Hinrich has returned to Chicago to have his right elbow examined, and the Bulls also played without center Joakim Noah and forward Carlos Boozer when they faced the Brooklyn Nets on Friday night.

Hinrich has been hampered by injuries for much of the season. He is averaging 7.0 points in 40 games.

He started Chicago's 104-88 victory at Milwaukee on Wednesday and finished with six points in 32 1/2 minutes.

The Bulls said Hinrich's status "will be determined once all medical information has been gathered."

Though the Bulls' notes said Noah had a right foot injury, coach Tom Thibodeau refused to specify before the game, calling it a "lower-body" injury. Pressed further, he said the All-Star was "nicked up."

Boozer has an injured right hamstring.

Taj Gibson and Nazr Mohammed started in the front-court along with Luol Deng, while Nate Robinson replaced Hinrich.

ABERDEEN — Thanks to a weather-related postponement, the Yankton Bucks wrestling team had to take on two of the top-ranked teams in the Eastern South Dakota Conference on the road on the same night.

The short-handed Bucks gave up four forfeits in a 54-19 loss to Aberdeen Central, and three in a 63-12 loss to Pierre. The Bucks had their hands full in the matches they did wrestle, as the Pierre roster boasts 13 ranked wrestlers, while Aberdeen Central features 11.

Against fourth-ranked Aberdeen Central, Noah Vetter (106) and Royce Reiser (285) won by pin. Casey Skillingsstad rolled to a 14-3 major decision at 132 pounds. James Hisek accounted for the other Bucks' points, beating Aberdeen's

Zach Melcher 2-1 in a battle of rated wrestlers, Hisek sixth and Melcher 10th.

In the dual against top-ranked Pierre, Yankton's Matt Huber, ranked fifth, scored a pin over 11th-ranked A.J. Dorschner at 145 pounds. Gabe Wenzlaff drew a forfeit at 120 pounds for the Bucks.
