For the past couple years, head coach Luke Youmans and the other members of the Yankton-Bon Homme gymnastics coaching staff have been telling my staff and I that the program was close to "turning the corner" and being among the more competitive programs in the state. Consider that corner turned. The Gazelles claimed a spot on the Class AA awards podium for the first time in several years with a seventh place finish at state. The program had finished sixth in the Eastern South Dakota Conference championships two weeks ago, but finished fifth among those teams on Friday.

'Corner' Finally Turned For Gazelles Gymnastics

There is still work to do, and Youmans would be the first to admit that. The program has still gone 15 years since its last top-10 individual showing at state (which could change today) Michelle Slowsky in the floor exercise and bars in 1998, and has gone 18 years since its last ESD individual champion, all-arounder Carrie Althoff in 1996.

The Gazelles still finished four points outside the top four and 17 points behind champion Rapid City Central. The latter may be a gap the program never completely overcomes, but the work that the student-athletes and coaches are doing during the season and outside the season in the River City Gymnastics program are definitely proving fruitful. And hopefully this taste of success on the state's biggest stage will leave the Gazelles hungry for more.
