MEAD UPDATE

More than 850 people attended the Mead Open House and Roof Completion Celebration on Saturday, Feb. 16. This was the public's last opportunity to visit before work begins on the interior of the building. This spring the process of abatement on the lead paint will begin, as well as work on the windows. During the Open House, Steve Kunkel of Stonebrook, Roofing, Inc. presented a check for \$30,000 to the Yankton County Historical Society for the Mead Building project. Stonebrook was the company dedicated to restoring and preserving the roof at the Mead Building. Some interesting stats from Stonebrook about the roof project: 5 tons of lumber; 3 tons of roofing underlayment; 4.5 tons of copper; 125 tons of clay tiles (majority of them original tiles); 2 tons of mortar; 1,500 pounds of nails and fasteners; and 390 cubic yards of "organic waste." People from across the tri-state region came to the event. One couple from Council Bluffs, Iowa, came to Yankton just for the event and to purchase a window at the Mead Building. There were also several community members that took this opportunity to visit the building for the first time. There will be a Mead Fundraising Event at the Historic Excelsior Flour Mill on March 16 from 7-10 p.m. Tickets on sale now at the Dakota Territorial Museum at 610 Summit Street in Westside Park, call 665-3898.
