likely to compromise any time soon on an increase in the minimum wage or other items on Obama's agenda.

The first bill the Democrats put on the Senate floor this vear. to renew benefits for the long-term unemployed, is stalled by Republican opposition. Even an eventual compromise wouldn't be much to brag about. Congress has passed similar bills repeatedly in the wake of past economic downturns.

Not that much of significance has been done up until now. With much fanfare, law-

makers recently completed work on a five-year farm bill two years late.

By month's end, lawmakers are virtually certain to raise the nation's debt limit. That, too, is a relatively routine measure, even if in recent years it has passed only after considerable brinkmanship. Another potential area for

compromise is legislation to overhaul the system for reimbursing doctors who treat Medicare patients. The bipartisan supporters

Omaha Tribe Casino To Reopen In New Building

The Omaha Tribe-owned casino, located in Onawa, Iowa, south of Sioux City, was shut down by Missouri River flooding in June 2011. The tribe reopened in a portion of the old building about a year ago while the new casino was under construction.

The new casino is next door to the old building, a portion of which will reopen in March as a bingo hall, marketing director Mike Krysl said.

"It's much like a phoenix rising out of the ashes," Krysl told the World-Herald. "We like to think of this as a situation where a blackbird is rising out of the flood waters."

The new building will sit 6 feet higher than the old casino to prevent future flooding, Krysl said.

About 140 people have been hired to staff the new casino, and a grand opening ceremony will be held Feb. 21.

Leaders from the Omaha Tribal Council will perform a cedar ceremony, a ritual intended to bless the new building.
