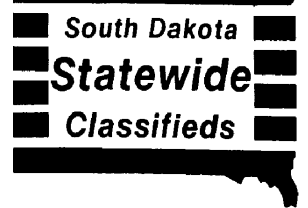

trade deals with Europe and Asia.

"I'm against fast track," said the man who sets the Senate's agenda, referring to the measure Obama wants. "I think everyone would be well advised just to not push this right now."

The legislation is opposed by large segments of organized labor, the very unions that Democrats will be counting on to pour money and manpower into their bid to hold control of the Senate in the November election.

Republicans need to gain six seats to win a majority. They say they increasingly are bullish about their prospects, what with the country generally pessimistic about the future, Obama's favorability ratings well below the levels of his re-election campaign, and controversies afflicting the president's health law.

While Reid hasn't said so, other lawmakers and aides speculate that trade could top the agenda of any postelection session of Congress.

An overhaul of tax laws seems further off than it did a year ago. There was scant evidence of progress in 2013, and now a transition is occurring at the Senate Finance Committee, where Sen. Ron Wyden, D-Ore., has yet to announce his priorities as incoming chairman. He will succeed Sen. Max

Omaha Tribe Casino To Reopen In New Building

OMAHA, Neb. (AP) — The Blackbird Bend casino in western Iowa, formerly CasinOmaha, is set to reopen in a brand-new building on Wednesday.

Table games, a restaurant and bar and gift shop are all coming back with the move to the new building, The Omaha World-Herald reported (http://bit.ly/1eclQPp).

The Omaha Tribe-owned casino, located in Onawa, Iowa, south of Sioux City, was shut down by Missouri River flooding in June 2011. The tribe reopened in a portion of the old building about a year ago while the new casino was under construction.

• RTEC manufacturing academy and an RTEC automobile academy in the summer; and
• Certified Nursing Academy (CNA) institute in the summer, as well as online CNA training

Those courses will be available to only Yankton students during the regular school, but will also be available to students at Avon, Bon Homme, Gayville-Volin and Irene-Wakonda through the Friday academies, Johnke said.

1,959, an average of nearly 49 hours per department member. The average turnout per call was 28 members.

Kurtenbach commended the number of volunteers who assist the department.

One area that did see an increase in 2013 was the total value in property damage, such as vehicles or structures, that endured a fire. The department's goal is 35 percent, Kurtenbach said, but that figure was 26.35 percent last year.

In 2012, the dollar value loss ratio was 11.66 percent, and 41.52 percent the year

Baucus, D-Mont., who was confirmed on Thursday as ambassador to China.

Deficit reduction, the driving force of the tea party-heavy House majority, now occupies a back seat, and the projected deficit for the current budget year is the lowest since George W. Bush was in the White House.

Nor do Republicans appear likely to compromise any time soon on an increase in the minimum wage or other items on Obama's agenda.

The first bill the Democrats put on the Senate floor this year, to renew benefits for the long-term unemployed, is stalled by Republican opposition. Even an eventual compromise wouldn't be much to brag about. Congress has passed similar bills repeatedly in the wake of past economic downturns.

Not that much of significance has been done up until now.

With much fanfare, lawmakers recently completed work on a five-year farm bill — two years late.

By month's end, lawmakers are virtually certain to raise the nation's debt limit. That, too, is a relatively routine measure, even if in recent years it has passed only after considerable brinkmanship.

Another potential area for compromise is legislation to overhaul the system for reimbursing doctors who treat Medicare patients.

The bipartisan supporters of a measure along those lines have yet to agree on how to offset the cost, though.

need areas in the work forces," Johnke said. "They're learning those skills that should be able to allow them to go on to a tech school, a four-year college or right into the work force."

Ultimately, that's the goal as well for Yankton Middle School, according to principal Todd Dvoracek.

Upgrading 8-year-old modules and expanded opportunities are the goal at YMS, he said.

"This is something that I think will be great," Dvoracek said. "We'll continue to offer programs kids can explore, and now they'll be able to see what actually takes place in a job setting."

The middle school not only plans to upgrade its modules, but also plans to use SDMyLife — an online career development tool through the South Dakota Department of Education — to open new interests for students, Dvoracek said.

"We're excited to bring some new things in, some different areas and different fields for kids to check out," he said. "At the middle school level, we want our kids to have a great idea for what they might want to do and start creating an interest."

"Then there's a good path set up for high school and on to college, or right into the work force."

Johnke credited the partnerships between RTEC, Mitchell Tech, Black Hills State, Avera Sacred Heart

Hospital, Yankton Rural Health Education Center and Yankton Area Progressive Growth (YAPG).

"We couldn't have done this without them," Johnke said.

Kindle, who especially recognized YPAG for a \$40,000 matching commitment, commended the governor and legislators for the support.

"A special thank you to our governor and legislators for seeing this need and supporting the Yankton School District through this grant."

The programs developed could, in turn, help attract more families to Yankton and could increase the number of students in the district, Kindle said.

"The school district would also benefit by increasing our student enrollment and providing students with enhanced educational opportunities," he said.

Among the other districts to be awarded grants was Vermillion, which receives \$99,380 for a public-private partnership in construction trades.

The Burke School District also received \$604,010 to go toward mobile units, in cooperation with Andes Central, Colome and South Central districts.

before.

"In some cases, we don't have any control over that," Kurtenbach said. "We've been to fully engaged house fires where the loss occurs before we even get there."

- Other accomplishments for 2013 include:
• ordered a new fire engine, the first city/rural shared apparatus;
• held a successful Fire Prevention Week;
• held several public fire safety education events throughout the year, contacting over 2,500 individuals;
• distributed 100 smoke detectors; and
• participated in several county-wide exercise and planning committees.

A common theme among most of those accomplishments were public aware-

ness, Kurtenbach said.

"We've gone out to apartment buildings and talked to residents about being fire safe and home safe," he said. "There were just a lot of contacts we made during the year."

Education is the key to prevention, Kurtenbach added.

"That's the biggest thing," he said. "If we can prevent a fire from happening, that would be nice to have a zero percent loss."
