The goal is to mobilize a generation to have a profound impact for God's Kingdom.

"The conference focus is to provide an opportunity for college-age students to hear some inspired teaching, to be challenged in their faith, and to become more greatly aware of the incredible plans and purpose that God has for their lives," said Chris Ver Steeg, Sunnybrook Community Church's director of connections and college ministry. "And in that process they are going to experience some great worship and some incredible authentic community that I think will change their lives."

Elevate is the college ministry at Sunnybrook and has a membership of approximately 150 students from nearby Morningside College, Western Iowa Tech Community College and Briar Cliff University. The Elevate Conference is open to young adults ages 18 to 25 and will feature three LIFE groups (interactive small-group discussions) and five sessions based on Biblical teachings from the book of Philippians 2: Humility, Exaltation, Worship, Community and Purpose. Session facilitators will include Ver Steeg and four others who are involved in the college ministry scene in the Midwest: David Wilch, youth director at Sunnybrook; Aaron Baart with the college ministry at Dordt College in Sioux Center, Iowa; Dusty Hoffman with the University of South Dakota's Cru (an interdenominational Christian group) student organi-

zation; and Adam Penning, director of the Badger Cru at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.)

"The main questions kids in college are asking is, 'What is my purpose in life? What's God's plan for my life? What's next?'" Ver Steeg said. "Come discover what your purpose is."

All Elevate Conference events take place at Sunnybrook Community Church, 5601 Sunnybrook Drive.
