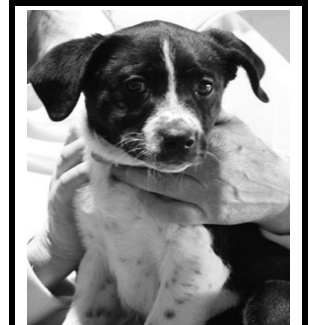

"So far this year, we've issued 88, which is kind of high," he said.

Ultimately, Vlahakis said there wasn't much change between 2013 and 2014.

"We're still a safe place to live," he said.

Also of note within the sheriff's report for 2014:

- The department issued 1,059 arrest warrants in 2014 versus 984 in 2013.

- The sheriff's department made 63 non-warrant arrests in 2014 versus 91 in 2013.

- 2,601 inmates were booked through the Yankton County Jail in 2014, eight less than in 2013 (2,609).

- The county also reported fewer escape attempts from the Human Services Center, jail and prison camp, with none in 2014 versus three in 2013.

The Yankton Police Department (YPD) also released its crime statistics for 2014. Overall, the number of incidents YPD responded to was slightly higher than the previous year

— 12,758 in 2014 versus 12,165 in 2013.

Some notable statistics include:

- The total number of traffic citations saw a large spike from 1,484 in 2013 to 1,701 in 2014.

- Citations for driving under the influence rose from 122 in 2013 to 154 in 2014. Other citations saw little to no change between the two years.

- One person was arrested for murder in 2014.

- The number of arrests for burglaries dropped from 12 in 2013 to five in 2014.

- The largest increases for adult arrests came from petty theft and drug-related offenses. In 2013, only 47 petty theft arrests were made, versus 100 in 2014. And 500 drug-related arrests were made in 2014 versus 361 the year before.

- The total number of adult arrests rose from 1,028 in 2013 to 1,287 in 2014.

- Juvenile arrests stayed largely the same, with 239 in 2014 versus 227 in 2013.

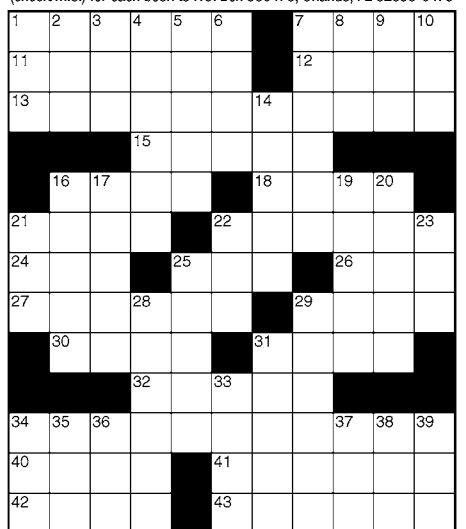
