SHERIDAN, Wyo. (AP) — Sheridan running back Jordan Roberts says he has verbally committed to play football for head coach Joe Glenn at the University of South Dakota.

The 5-foot-11, 193-pound Roberts led the Broncos to the Class 4A state football championship last year.

The Sheridan Press reports that this past season, he rushing for 2,688 yards and 38 touchdowns on 308 carries while maintaining a 3.61 GPA in the classroom.

Glenn was head coach at Wyoming from 2002-2008. Last December, he was hired as head coach at South Dakota, an NCAA Football Championship subdivision team.
