"I'm encouraging the president not to negotiate on the debt ceiling," Johnson added. He also stated that he has no major issues with Obama nominees Jack Lew and Chuck Hagel, who have been nominated as Treasury Secretary and Secretary of Defense, respectively. "Unless a person is obviously, egregiously wrong for the job, I think the president deserves his own picks as the Cabinet secretaries," Johnson said. He is surprised about the opposition that has sprung up to Hagel's nomination, but doesn't think that will ultimately be a deciding factor. "I expect that Chuck Hagel will be confirmed," Johnson said. Finally, Johnson stated that he hopes to see a five-year Farm Bill negotiated by March.

Arizona Governor Opts For Federal Medicaid Expansion

PHOENIX (AP) — Arizona Gov. Jan Brewer said Monday she plans to push for an expansion of the state's Medicaid program under the federal health care law, a surprising decision that could have an impact on other Republican governors weighing a similar decision. Brewer has opposed the federal health care law known as the Affordable Care Act, citing worries over a potential overreliance on federal funding. A provision in the 2010 law allows for states to increase Medicaid coverage, and Brewer told lawmakers in her annual State of the State address on Monday that virtually all of the expansion would be funded by the federal government. Not taking the money wouldn't contribute to the lowering of federal deficits, she said. Any increase would also "include a circuit-breaker that automatically" would roll back enrollment if federal reimbursement rates decrease, Brewer said. "I won't allow Obamacare to become a bait-and-switch," she said. Brewer's decision was being closely watched across the country, particularly since Arizona was among the states that sued to overturn Obama's law. After the last summer's Supreme Court ruling upholding the law, Brewer considered a partial expansion, but the administration rejected that approach. Brewer on Monday cited President Barack Obama's re-election and the Supreme Court ruling as evidence of the law's permanence. She also referenced a brief and unpleasant encounter between her and the president that was captured by photographers. The argument on a Mesa airport tarmac was a highly visible demonstration of the verbal and legal skirmishing that has regularly occurred between Brewer and Obama's administration over illegal immigration and other issues.

Johnson said. "A skilled workforce is critical for our state, and the people being trained at RTEC are filling important jobs in technical fields." Vermillion/Yankton Joint Powers solid waste management system. Abourezk said that "entire Alawite villages" are currently being slaughtered by the Syrian rebels. "Pay no attention to what the American press says about this," he said. "They're following the government line. The government line is to support the rebels, and they're not going to run anything on television or in major newspapers that will help Assad. They want Assad out, so the press goes along with it." The former senator's wife comes from Syria and is herself an Alawite. Her family still lives in an Alawite area, he said. "She talks to them every day by telephone to make sure they're OK," he said. "They give her the news every day, and Alawite villages, one after the other, captured by the rebels, and they slaughter the people there. Then they take photos of it and they say, 'The government did this.' "The propaganda machine by the rebels is almost perfect, and they're being aided by money from Saudi Arabia and Qatar," he said. Abourezk added that if there were no involvement from Israel, "we wouldn't be involved as much as we are." The main reason for this is lobbyists, he said. "The Israeli government has a lobby in Washington that threatens and terrifies every politician in Washington, except for one or two," Abourezk said. "They didn't terrify me, although they came after me many, many times. "The American government is virtually under the control of the Israelis when it comes to foreign policy in the Middle East. I know it's harsh to say, but it's true, and I've seen it first-hand. It deals with money. ... If they don't agree with your position on Israel, you don't get any money. You'll have money given to your opposition," he said. As a result, Abourezk said the Israeli government gets a pass on issues such as the occupation of the Gaza Strip and the West Bank, and the 2010 attack on flotillas that left nine people dead, including one American. "Our government never said a word about it," Abourezk said. The only solution is to pass a law regarding the financing of election campaigns, he said. "If you have that, you don't have the Israeli lobby threatening people with cutting off their campaign money," he said. Toward the end of the event, Abourezk said the U.S. would not support an occupation anywhere else in the world. "In this case, we send Israel money," he said. The event was moderated by Dr. Benno Wymar.

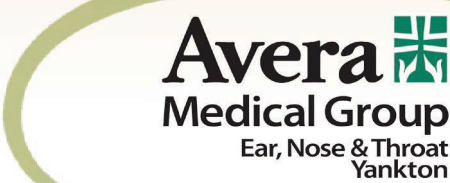
