‘Harbaugh Bowl’ Set

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. (AP) — Joe Flacco outdueled Tom Brady, throwing three touchdown passes in the second half and leading the Baltimore Ravens to their first Super Bowl in 12 years with a 28-13 victory over the New England Patriots on Sunday for the AFC championship.

The win sets up the first Super Bowl coached by brothers, Baltimore's John Harbaugh and San Francisco's Jim. The 49ers won the NFC title earlier Sunday 28-24 at Atlanta.

The 49ers have been listed as 5-point favorites.

Baltimore linebacker Ray Lewis' final season will conclude in two weeks in New Orleans; he was the MVP of the 2001 game, the Ravens' only Super Bowl win.

Flacco had two touchdown passes to Anquan Boldin and one to Dennis Pitta as the Ravens

outscored the Patriots 21-0 in the second half. Baltimore's defense made Brady look ordinary and stymied the league's top offense.

Brady was 67-0 at home when leading at halftime.

49ERS 28, FALCONS 24: ATLANTA (AP) — The 49ers defense needed time to warm up, then shut out the Falcons in the second half and allow San Francisco to stage a record rally in the NFC championship game.

Linebacker NaVorro Bowman knocked away a fourth-down pass intended for Rodney White with a 1-13 left field presave a 28-24 victory Sunday that sent San Francisco to the Super Bowl for the first time since 1995.

It was yet another big play for a defense that allowed Atlanta to take a 17-0 early in the second quarter, and a 24-14 lead at halftime. The 49ers put the clamps on Matt Ryan and Atlanta's high-powered passing attack over the final 30 minutes.

Midway through the third, cornerback Chris Culliver intercepted a pass by Ryan at the San Francisco 38. Though the Niners' offense failed to score off the turnover when David Akers missed a 38-yard field goal attempt, defensive end Aldon Smith followed on the next defensive series by recovering Ryan's fumble on a botched shotgun snap.

The turn of events contrasted sharply from the early stages of the game when the 49ers appeared to have no answer for Ryan, White, Julio Jones and Tony Gonzalez.

MINNEAPOLIS — Megan Glisar became the second Coyote woman to win an event this season by winning the high jump, while the Coyote men recorded 10 top-five finishes en route to a second-place finish at the Jack Johnson Invitational on Saturday.

Glisar, a transfer from Morningside College, won with a jump of 5-9 1/4. She was joined in scoring in that event by freshman Taryn Derickson, who placed sixth with a 5-3 mark in her Coyote debut.

For the men, the Coyotes were led by three top-five finishers in the triple jump. Cody Linder placed second with a 47-0 1/4 mark, while Chad Pinkelman was third at 44-3 1/2. Jeff O’Connell finished fourth at 43-8.

In the pole vault, Kyle Ballew recorded a second-place finish at 16-4 3/4, and teammate Peter Chapman placed seventh at 15-1.

Outside of Glisar and Derickson, the women had a pair of individual sixth-place finishes with Ashley Sveum running 58.13 in the 400-meters and Rachel Weinandt running 1:40.80 in the 600-meters.
