VERMILION — Junior distance runner Jeff Mettler was named Indoor Track Athlete of the Week by the Summit League on Tuesday. It's the first time a member of the Coyote men's team has earned the honor.

Mettler placed second in the 3000-meters at Saturday's Jack Johnson Invitational, finishing with a league-best time of 8:20.82. The time was 16th-best in Division I this season. He was the top collegiate finisher in the event, and was five seconds off the indoor record of 8:15.46 he set last season.
