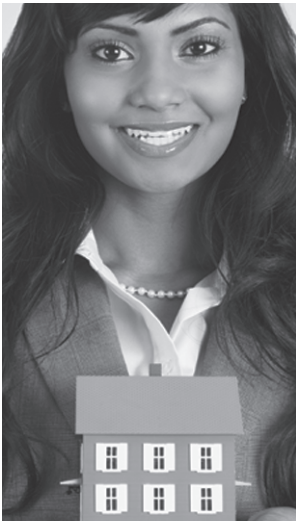

December Water Report
Board members reviewed the December water report revealing one account delinquent. A turn-off notice will be posted at the residential home. Water service will be shut off if no payment is received by Friday, Jan 18th. Discussion was held on the minimum sewer rate for the apartment complex now empty. Water Superintendent

Scherschligt will be installing replacement street signs within the community. Lift station equipment is working well, and the water flow at the lagoon has broken through the ice so no problems have been experienced.

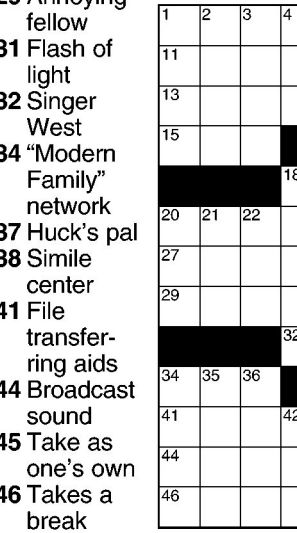

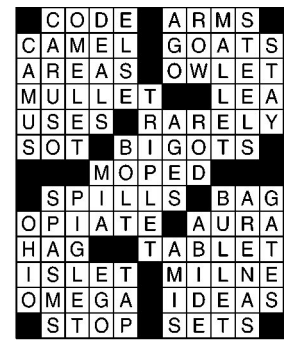

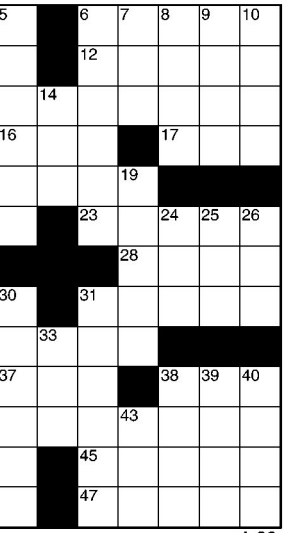
