10-11 in Pierre during the state legislative session.

And chances are, he will be wearing a suit and tie — Kleinschmit's usual attire when he is out in the community doing various work, his mother said.

"That's what he was known for around town," Toni said. "There was one time where I got a call from a dentist's office that Kyle walked in one afternoon all dressed up and said, 'Good afternoon, ladies.'"

"People get a kick out of his personality."

Among his many extracurricular ventures, Kleinschmit is actively involved with Teen Court — a nearly year-old program — through the Boys & Girls Club. On many occasions, Kleinschmit enthusiastically embraces a role as a defense attorney, according to Teen Court Coordinator Kelsie Thoreson. "He's always willing to step in, even if we need jury members," Thoreson said. "He always wants to know when the next court is."

Held on the first and third Mondays of each month, Yankton's Teen Court is focused on "repairing the harm caused by first offenders," according to its website. Not only does Kleinschmit show up to every session, but he comes prepared, Thoreson said.

"Kyle is very energetic; definitely a go-getter," she said. "He's someone that I can always rely on. If we're in a bind or need some help, he's always willing to help out with our programs. ... He's a very reliable and responsible young man."

Though he still has three years of high school remaining, Kyle said he already has

his future mapped out. After graduation, he wants to join the Army National Guard — "to serve my country as best I can" — and wants to pursue a career in criminal justice to eventually become a police officer.

His experiences with Teen Court, naturally, help in that endeavor, Kyle said.

"It helps me understand why the kids are doing what they do," he said.

Before embarking on his post-high school life, Kyle is first focusing on his presentation at the state Youth of the Year competition. He will give a speech to a panel of judges and will then be asked questions about it.

"I think he has a very good chance, as long as he comes prepared," Thoreson said. "And I have no doubt he'll be ready."

Unlike the first round of competition, Kleinschmit will not be able to use notecards for his speech at the state level. No problem, his mother said.

"He's so confident, even with something like this," Toni said. "He practices his speech pretty much every night."

What does he plan to talk about? Kyle plans to discuss why education is important and why he joined the Boys & Girls Club, he said.

Giving speeches to audiences, small or large, is nothing new for Kyle, his mother said. Within the past year, he gave a speech in downtown Yankton with the Boys & Girls Club, and wowed the crowd.

"He got up there and I was just shocked," Toni said. "It was like he's been doing it for 50 years."

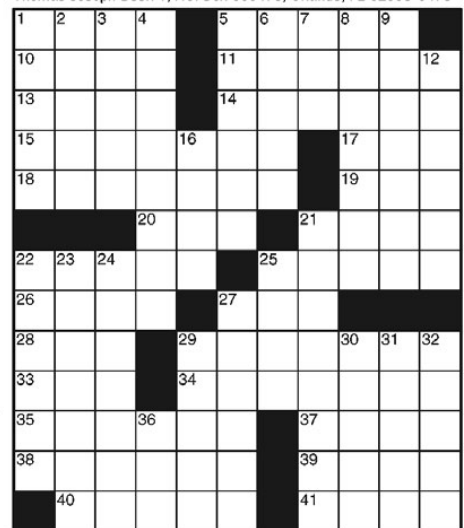
