USD's Glisar, Musa Named

SL Athletes Of The Week

ELMHURST, Ill. — South Dakota swept the Summit League's weekly Indoor Track and Field Athlete of the Week awards with senior Megan Glisar earning the women's honor and Mubarik Musa winning the men's honor.

Glisar, a senior from Sergeant Bluff, Iowa, cleared 5 feet, 10 1/2 inches to win the high jump at the Holiday Inn Invitational in Lincoln, Neb., this past weekend. Her mark is tied for eighth-best in the nation and is 4 1/2 inches better than the next best mark in the league.

Musa, a redshirt freshman distance runner from Worthington, Minn., recorded a NCAA top-40 time in the 5,000-meters at the Holiday Inn Invitational, finishing second in 14:57.55. His time is the

best in the league and ranks 37th in the nation.

USD will compete at the Jack Johnson Invitational in Minneapolis on Friday and Saturday and at the Wildcat Open in Wayne, Neb., on Saturday.

ELMHURST, Ill. — South Dakota freshman Greysen Hertting has been named Summit League Women's Diver of the Week as announced by the league office Tuesday.

Hertting received her third consecutive Summit League weekly honor after sweeping both diving events in the Coyotes' 208-82 victory against league opponent Western Illinois. The freshman won the one-meter dive with a score of 265.49 and the three-meter with 276.83 points.

This award makes it the eighth of 11 total Summit weekly honors that Hertting has received. It is also her second string of three straight honors.

CSM Names USD's Bos

Player Of The Week

VERMILLION — South Dakota junior guard Brandon Bos has been named Summit League Player of the Week as announced by College

Sports Madness for the period ended Jan. 19. Bos averaged 17 points in leading the Coyotes to a pair of Summit League victories that propelled the team to the top of the standings.

Bos made a season-high four three-pointers and scored 21 points in a 69-57 win against IUPUI Thursday. He followed that up with a 13-point performance in a 14-point win against Fort Wayne, a team that entered 9-1 in its last 10 games.

Bos made 13 of 27 shots during the week and was 3 of 3 from the free-throw line. He also pulled down 10 rebounds and had three assists, two blocks and a steal.

On the season, Bos leads the team in scoring with 13.5 points a contest. He has made 27 three-pointers, makes 86 percent of his free throws and has 45 assists.

North Earns NSIC Honor

BURNSVILLE, Minn. — Augustana's TJ North went undefeated in four matches, taking down the No. 1-ranked wrestler in his weight class, and earned Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference wrestler of the week.

A sophomore from Elk Point, North allowed just five points in his four bouts while scoring 26 with three decision wins and a major decision. North is now 20-3 on the season with a perfect 10-0 record

against Division II competition.

North opened the week with a 7-1 decision over Antonio Meikel of Southwest Minnesota State, pushing his NSIC record to 3-0 on the season.

Ranked No. 5 in NCAA Division II at 125 pounds, North would be tested at the Ranger Duals over the weekend. North welcomed the challenge, first taking down Jose Torres of No. 15 McKindree, who is ranked No. 3 in his Super Region, with a commanding 10-2 major decision.

North carried his momentum into a top-five battle, pitting him against the top-ranked 125-pound wrestler, Alex Johns of No. 10 Indianapolis. North would come out on top, defeating Johns 3-1, helping the Vikings to a 38-9 win.

In his final match of the week, North dispatched Ben Sergeant of Findlay, a wrestler returning from an All-American performance, one year ago. With a 6-1 decision, North finished the week undefeated and sparked the Vikings to a 34-9 win over Findlay.

This is North's first athlete of the week honors, second for the Vikings this year — Michael Lowman earned the accolades on Nov. 26 after winning the Holiday Inn Open.

Augustana returns to the road, taking on Augsburg and Minnesota State on Jan. 24 and 25, respectively.
