Wrestling: SDSU's Kocer

Makes NCAA Rankings

INDIANAPOLIS — Alex Kocer was one of three South Dakota State wrestlers ranked as the NCAA Coaches Panel released its first rankings of the season on Thursday.

Kocer, a redshirt freshman 149-pounder from Wagner, ranks 33rd in the poll. He has won a team-best 20 matches on the season.

Also ranked for SDSU were Cody Pack, a returning NCAA qualifier who is ranked 19th at 157 pounds, and junior Joe Brewster, ranked 33rd at 165 pounds.

The final rankings, along with RPI and winning percentage, are used as part of the selection process for the NCAA Wrestling Championships, set for March 20-22 at Oklahoma City, Okla.
