S.D. Sports Hall Of Fame Tickets Now Available

SIOUX FALLS — Tickets are on sale for the 2014 South Dakota Sports Hall of Fame banquet to be held Saturday, April 12, at the Sioux Falls Convention Center.

All tickets are being handled exclusively by Dakota Sports in Sioux Falls (605-332-2131). There is a discounted price for tickets, if purchased by April 9.

A social hour starts at 4:30 p.m. with the dinner at 6 and the program at 7.

Nine people will be inducted into the Hall of Fame, bringing the membership to 245.

Ted Kessinger and Mel Tjerdema, two of the nation's greatest small-college football coaches, are among the inductees. Also chosen were three former South Dakota State athletes: Jay Dirksen,

Herb Bartling and Arnold "Nig" Johnson. Other honorees are football player Dick Callahan, basketball player Jack Theeler, baseball player Doug Stanford and softball pitcher Paul Ferrie.

Kessinger lives in Lindsborg, Kan.; Tjerdema in Marlyle, Mo.; Dirksen in Hot Springs Village, Ark.; Bartling in San Antonio; Johnson in Cottage Grove, Minn.; Callahan in Denver; Theeler in Mitchell; and Stanford in Deadwood. Ferrie is being honored posthumously.

The Hall of Fame was established by the South Dakota Sports Writers Association in 1968 and is now an independent non-profit organization.

SDSU Stadium Meetings Jan. 29

SIOUX FALLS — South Dakota State University officials will continue a series of information sessions regarding a proposed new football stadium with two public town hall meetings Jan. 29 in Sioux Falls.

The town hall meetings are scheduled for 12 noon and 5:30 p.m. on the top floor of the Holiday

Inn City Center in downtown Sioux Falls. SDSU Director of Athletics Justin Sell will provide an update of the project, followed by a question-and-answer session. A light lunch will be provided.

The proposed stadium, which would be built on the existing Coughlin-Alumni Stadium site, would seat between 18,500 and 20,000 spectators. Total cost of the project, which would be done in phases and completed prior to the 2016 season, is estimated between \$60 and \$65 million. Lead gifts totaling \$12.5 million were received in October from Sioux Falls banker Dana Dykhouse and philanthropist T. Denny Sanford. Subsequent financial commitments have brought the total raised for the project to nearly \$20 million. The remaining amount — up to \$39 million — would be financed through the issuance of revenue bonds by the South Dakota Building Authority.

In December 2013, the South Dakota Board of Regents approved the facility plan and advanced the project to the South Dakota Legislature for final approval. The stadium project has been assigned to Senate Bill 15.

Other town hall meetings are planned to be

held in Rapid City and Pierre, with dates to be determined.

Oakland AD Leaving Position At End Of Month

ROCHESTER, Mich. (AP) — Oakland University athletic director Tracy Huth is leaving his position at the end of the month.

Huth says it's been "amazing" to witness the growth of the school and its athletic program, but it's time for a new chapter in his life.

Huth has spent over 30 years at Oakland as an athlete, coach and administrator.

Oakland has been involved in a legal dispute with former women's basketball coach Beckie Francis, who was fired in June and sued the school to get specific information on the firing. Officials at the Detroit-area school have said that Francis physically and emotionally abused players, obsessed about their weight and pushed Christian beliefs on them. Francis's lawyer has called the accusations of abuse a smear.
