where physique was everything.

The Olympic games were an example of the culture's goal to find or be the 'perfect man.' However, over Christmas we celebrated the birth of the only perfect man there ever will be.

Striving to be perfect outwardly while neglecting spiritual matters is ill

advised and will prove costly.

Keeping up with the battle of the bulge is difficult to say the least and some may be tempted to give up on spiritual things as well.

However, Proverbs 24:16 says "for though the righteous fall seven times, they rise again." and David wrote "though he stumble, he will not fall, for the Lord upholds him with His hand" (Psalm 37:24).

The Lord promises not only to help, but also to bless us in this life if we find those things that please Him.

I am confident in saying that using 'grit, determination, and sacrifice' in spiritual matters this coming year will allow us to walk past the mirror with much less concern or discontent.
