USD Wins Six Events At Holiday Inn Invitational

LINCOLN, Neb.—South Dakota's women's distance medley, senior Kyle McKelvey, junior Madison Mills and red-shirt Megan Glisar each claimed event titles as the South Dakota track and field teams competed at day two of the Holiday Inn Invitational on Saturday.

The South Dakota women scored 123 points and finished runner-up in the team standings, while the men took fourth with 39 points. Nebraska won the men's and women's team titles.

The distance medley, composed of freshmen Bethany Kozak and Cami Brenner, sophomore Nicole Schmidt and junior Katie Wetzstein, won in 11:44.40. The time ranks as the third-best in school history.

McKelvey recorded a new career best of 59-5 3/4 in the men's indoor shot put to win the event. Teammate senior Cody Snyder placed fourth with a toss of 56-11 1/2.

South Dakota claimed three of the top four spots in the women's pole vault. Mills won in 13-2 1/2, freshman Hannah Meador finished runner-up in 12-10 3/4 and sophomore Emily Brigham placed fourth in a new

indoor career best of 12-6 3/4.

In the seeded women's high jump, Glisar competed untached and jumped a height of 5-10 3/4 to take the event. Freshman Colette Christensen finished sixth at 5-4 1/2.

On Friday night Wetzstein and junior Amber Eichkorn added wins in the mile and 5,000-meter run, respectively, to bring South Dakota to six total wins at the invitational.

Wetzstein ran a time of 4:52.14 to break the previous record of 4:52.50 set by Ramsey (Kavan) Fitzsimmons in 2008. Wetzstein's time ranks 13th in Division I and leads the Summit League by more than five seconds.

The Coyotes added 11 more top-eight performances on Saturday. South Dakota's women's 4x400 relay finished third in 3:51.73 and the men's distance medley placed fourth in 10:11.35. Junior Analisa Hushle added a fourth-place finish in the 200 dash (25.07 seconds) and eighth-place finish in the 60 dash (7.75 seconds). Sophomore Danielle Waldner and junior Meghan Dennis placed fourth and fifth in the women's shot put. Seniors Lindsey Montileaux and

Rachel Weinandt took fifth and sixth, respectively, in the 600-meter run. Senior Amber Watson placed sixth in the 400-meter dash, junior Peter Chapman finished sixth in the pole vault and sophomore Tyler Frank took eighth in the high jump to round out the list.

South Dakota returns to the track Saturday at 12:30 p.m. for the South Dakota State Alumni Invitational in Brookings.

SIoux CENTER, Iowa — The Mount Marty College track and field team scored a dozen top-10 finishes in the season-opening Dordt Invitational on Saturday.

Abbey VanDenBerg led the way for the MMC women, finishing third in the triple jump (35-5 1/2) and tenth in the long jump (15-10 1/2). Jordyn Hudelson also earned two top-10 finishes, seventh in the mile (5:42.22) and ninth in the 1,000 (3:16.54).

Also for the Lancer women, Karen Mayfield placed fourth in the 3,000 (11:40.14), Mandy O'Malley placed fifth in the 600 (1:46.40), Mykaela Hughes finished seventh in the high jump (4-10) and Emily Boyle placed eighth in the pole vault (9-5 1/2).

For the Lancer men, Tyler Payer finished seventh in the long jump (19-9 3/4) and eighth in the high jump (5-9). Jordan Houdek finished tenth in the 600 (1:27.76). Adam Haigh placed tenth in the pole vault (12-7 1/2).
