But that doesn't make the desire to reach and inspire people any less relevant.

"Theatre is a way to help and entertain people," said Schaeffer, who originally majored in political science when he started at USD. "You strive to make people feel things."

That help became particularly evident for Schaeffer during a play at USD he acted in called "Next to Normal," which touches on mental health.

"A friend of mine had just broken up with his girlfriend, and he really connected with my character in the play," Schaeffer said. "There was an understanding and appreciation and such a novelty of emotions. It's a beautiful challenge to move people."

For Vortherms, the idea of acting professionally never would have been apparent if it hadn't been for her roots in Yankton's community theatre.

"Yankton has a really good program and support," she said. "I wouldn't have even considered this if it hadn't been for the community theatre side getting me involved."

Tieszen acknowledged there isn't a current situation prompting need for the protection. "It is hypothetical at this point," he said.

The 20 nays were the first "no" votes cast on a bill in the Senate this year.

Sen. David Novstrup, R-Aberdeen, gave notice of his intent to seek reconsideration of the vote. He contacted Jackley later in the afternoon about whether to proceed.

"It's his bill. It's his decision," Novstrup said.

Jackley previously described the legislation, Senate Bill 11, as an attempt to restore protections that previously were in state law.

They were repealed as part of a broader cleanup several years ago by the Dauggaard administration.
