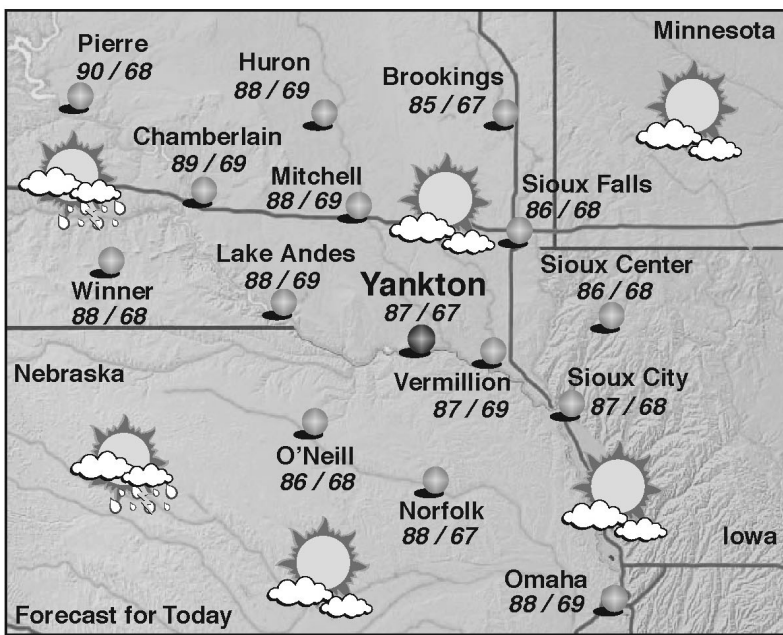

Public Encouraged To Attend Tractor Ride

Nearly 200 tractors converge on Yankton today (Friday) and Saturday for the 2011 WNAX/Tri-State Old Iron two-day tractor ride. Rodger Harts, an event organizer, said 183 tractors from as far away as New York and the Twin Cities are registered for the fifth annual event. The caravan follows a route through southeast South Dakota today and northeast Nebraska on Saturday. The event is free and originates in Yankton both days. The public is encouraged to witness tonight's parade in downtown Yankton. Today, the riders leave Paddlewheel Point in Yankton at 7 a.m., travel along new Highway 50 and turn north to Utica. After a short break at the Community Center in Utica, the entrants ride toward

Jamesville Colony, then along the James River and stop at the Scotland VFW for the noon meal. After lunch, the participants travel to Lesterville, then south to the Sub Shop and east to Utica to stop at the Community Center for another break. They finish the ride on Highway 81. The route covers 72.2 miles. The Happy Go Lucky 4H Club serves the refreshments in Utica. The Friday parade in downtown Yankton starts at 6 p.m. The drivers leave Paddlewheel Point, come up Third Street and over to Cedar Avenue, with WNAX announcing each driver and something about the entrant for the spectators. The riders go south to Riverside Drive and park down by the amphitheater for a catered dinner immediately following the parade.

Saturday, riders leave Paddlewheel Point, go down Highway 50 to Timber Road, and follow the road along the north side of the Missouri River. The parade entries then proceed through downtown Vermillion, south to the airport, over to Highway 19, across the new bridge and into Nebraska. After the noon meal at Maskell, the riders travel to Obert, go north out of Obert to get along the Missouri River. The participants then travel to the Wiseman Monument and over Rattlesnake Road to St. Helena. After an afternoon break, the riders return to Yankton. The route covers 76.4 miles, with a 20-minute morning break at Bergen Lutheran Church, a 45-minute lunch break at Faith Lutheran Church in Maskell and a 20-minute break at St. Helena park.

CHICAGO (AP) — Grains futures rose Thursday on the Chicago Board of Trade.

Wheat for September delivery rose 7.50 cents to \$6.3450 a bushel; December corn added 7 cents to \$6.1550 a bushel; December oats rose 3.25 cents to \$3.5225 a bushel; while November soybeans rose 19.25 cents to \$13.3775 a bushel.

Beef and pork futures traded higher or flat on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.

August live cattle added 1.77 cent to \$1.1472 a pound; August feeder cattle rose 2.95 cents to \$1.4390 a pound; August lean hogs added 2.67 cents to 96.27 cents a pound; while August pork bellies were unchanged at \$1.065 a pound.
