**GOLD COAST, Australia (AP)** — Michael Phelps is predicting the long world record drought in swimming will come to an end this month at the world championships in Shanghai, and he is best qualified to know.

The 26-year-old has dominated swimming recently, winning eight of his 14 Olympic gold medals at the 2008 Beijing Games, and is competing in up to seven events at the world championships.

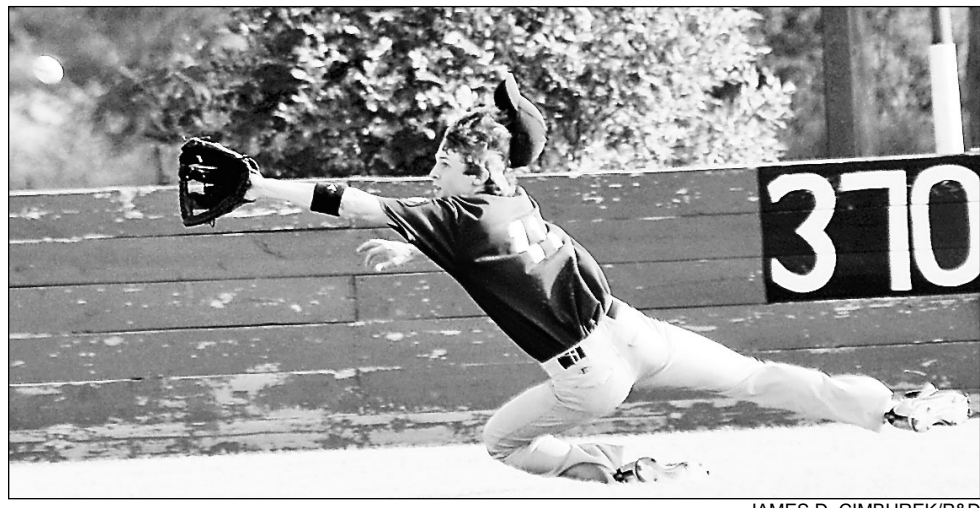
Swimming's world record drought has reached 18 months in the Olympic-size 50-meter pool since the ban on rubberized suits at the beginning of 2010.

## Phelps Predicts Record Drought Will End At Worlds

"People just want it more now. We're going to see faster swimming than we've really ever seen," Phelps said after a training session Friday at Southport on Australia's Gold Coast, where the U.S. team is preparing for the championships. "There are going to be a lot faster swimmers than the Olympics or the world swimming championships in '09 — even with the suits we have now."

An incredible 43 world records were set at the world championships in Rome two years ago, including Phelps' marks in the butterfly and 400 medley, and overall between 2008 and 2009 — the rubberized suit era — there were more than 200 records set over long- and short-course.

## San Diego Assistant Named New SDSU Softball Coach

BROOKINGS — Kim Aggabao, an assistant coach at the University of San Diego the past seven seasons, has been hired as head softball coach at South Dakota State University, Athletic Director Justin Sell announced Wednesday.

"I am very excited to lead the next chapter for South Dakota State softball," Aggabao said. "I am so grateful to be part of this wonderful university and first-class athletic department. I am looking forward

to working with the team, and helping them achieve great things on the field, in the classroom, and in the Brookings community."

At the University of San Diego, Aggabao (pronounced AG-ah-bou) served as the team's hitting coach, infield coach and recruiting coordinator. The Toreros increased their win total each of the past three seasons, posting a 24-19 overall mark in 2011. The squad also turned in its third consecutive winning campaign in conference play with a second-place record of 14-6 in the Coastal Division of the Pacific Coast Softball Conference.

"Through her success as a player and coach, Kim Aggabao knows what it takes to build a winning program," Sell said. "She has played, coached and recruited in one of the prime areas of the country for softball and we look forward to having her share her knowledge of the game with our Jackrabbit team starting this fall."

A native of Walnut, Calif., Aggabao played at UC San Diego, where she graduated in 2004 with a degree in biology. She was a four-year starter at the middle infield positions and earned first-team all-California Collegiate Athletic Association honors three times. Aggabao was selected as the CCAA Most Valuable Player and was named to the all-West Region Second Team her senior season, when she led the league with a .411 batting average and set a

school record with 23 doubles.

Aggabao will begin her duties at South Dakota State on July 25.
