to take a channel flowing east from the mouth to the Missouri River because it is the easiest route.

"Basically, when the Jim and Missouri are low enough, you'll have no flow and it will probably build up a natural barrier and seal itself off until the next particularly large event," he said. "It's a very natural thing for all these dynamics to occur on a river. The thing that's happened here that is different is that it is a semi-controlled system. These rivers just naturally change course, typically in response to one particularly large event.

"From a cursory look, it seems like one of the largest potential problems may be what occurs when you go upstream from the mouth of the James," Driscoll continued. "It may tend to cause higher flood stages than before with the same flow.

The USGS has the capability to do hydrologic studies and begin to assess what is occurring, he stated.

We would do such a study only at the request of and in cooperation with interested agencies," Driscoll said. "A higher likelihood is that, because the U.S. Army Corps of

Engineers is the agency in charge of control of the river system, they may look at the situation and make some sort of assessment."

However, Bartel has spoken with the Corps and has been told the agency doesn't plan to get involved beyond issuing permits for work, if needed.

'The Corps doesn't feel this is their responsibility, according to the people I've talked to." he said. "I guess they have other fish to fry at this point.

Bartel has higher hopes for USGS involvement.

"They're willing to come down and do some studies and maybe give us a starting point of where to go," he said. They may be the salvation if they let us know where to go. Dredging may be needed,

Bartel said.

"I think the way it is, it's going to continually back the river up more and more," he stated. "Now is the time we should do something before it gets any worse. We don't want to lose any of that river bottom farm ground. It takes a lot of money out of the economy if we do that. We'll see if somebody wants to step up to the plate and take this on as a project. I would certainly help them as much as possible.

# **House GOP Drops Food** Stamp Cuts From Farm Bill

WASHINGTON (AP) - Republican leaders hoping to recover from an embarrassing defeat on the House floor last month are preparing to split a massive farm bill in two and put it up for a vote as early as Thursday.

The GOP House leadership released a smaller version of the five-year bill late Wednesday, dropping a politically sensitive section of the legislation that would have made small cuts to the \$80 billion-a-year food stamp program. Republicans are divided on how big cuts should be to food stamps, which have doubled in cost in the last five years. Democ-

rats have opposed any cuts. Republicans have been counting votes for the bill

to gather support from conservatives who voted against the \$100 billion-a-year farm bill. The House rejected the farm bill in June by a vote of 234-195, with 62 Republicans voting against it. Many of those GOP critics said the bill's 3 percent cut in food stamps was not enough.

The idea is that the farm portion of the bill, which contains about \$2 billion a year in cuts to farm subsidies, could pass without the food stamp provisions. By splitting the two, Republicans might be able to make bigger cuts in food stamp programs and pass that bill with conservative support.
