Mead Update

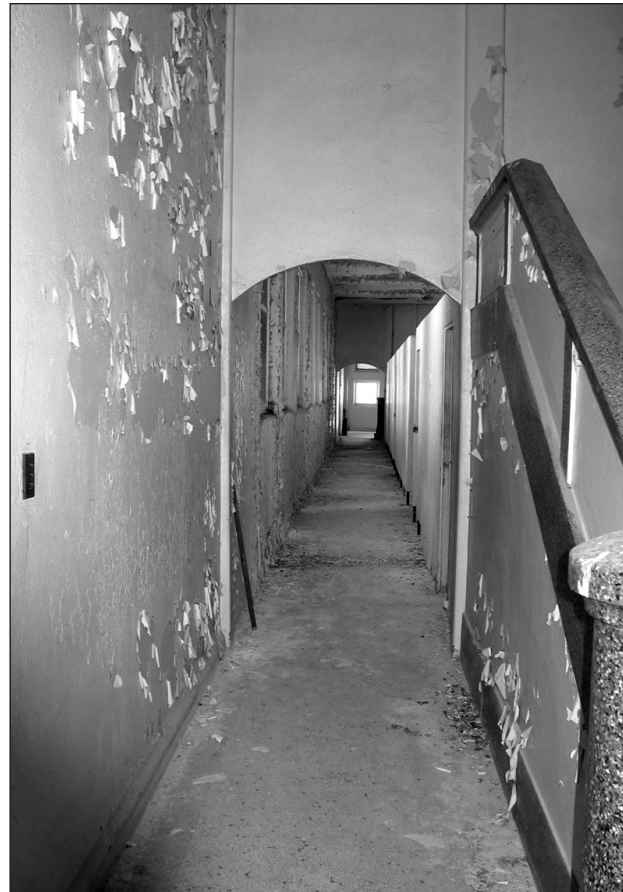
