**USD Cross Country Releases 2013 Schedule**

VERMILLION — Two home meets and an early look at the Midwest Regional course in Ames, Iowa, highlight the 2013 South Dakota cross-country schedule released today by head coach Dan Fitzsimmons.

The slate begins Sept. 6 in Vermillion with the Don Baker Invitational and builds towards November's Summit League and NCAA regional championships.

"This schedule allows us to see good competition without racing too early before the big meets hit in November," said Fitzsimmons. "We will race against Nebraska, Creighton and Omaha on our home course and I know our team and our fans are excited for those meets."

In addition to the Don Baker Invitational, the Coyotes host the Tim Young Invitational Oct. 19. Sandwiched between the two home meets are the Iowa State Invitational on Sept. 21 and the South Dakota State Classic on Oct. 4.

Fort Wayne hosts the Summit League Championships on Nov. 2. Iowa State hosts the NCAA regional Nov. 15. The Coyote men and women runners up at the Summit a year ago. The men placed 12th at the NCAA Midwest Regional while the women finished 14th.

The USD men return six of seven runners from last year's team including senior Jeff Mettler, last year's Summit League runner up. The Coyote women will rely on five of their top eight from a year ago including three seniors and 2012 Summit League Newcomer of the Meet Amber Eichorn.

**Lickteig, Two From Parkston Win Junior Tour Events**

SIOUX FALLS — Former Freeman prep standout Arron Lickteig and Parkston's Sydney Bormann and Sydney Weber took home titles in the South Dakota Golf Association's junior tour event in Sioux Falls on Wednesday.

Older golfers played at Prairie Green Golf Course, while younger golfers played Elmwood Golf Course.

Lickteig, a Marion native and Fox Run member, shot a 70 to win the boys' 16-18 year-old division. Yankton's Brandon Frick tied for second at 71. Parkston's Jake Weber shot a 75 to finish in the top 10.

Bormann shot a 72 to finish five strokes ahead of Sioux Falls' Abbie Grevios in the girls' 16-18 year-old division.

Weber edged Yankton's Becky Frick in the girls' 14-15 year-old division, shooting a 79 to beat Frick by one stroke. Yankton's Payton Pierce shot 100 to finish fifth.

In the boys' 12-13 year-old division at Elmwood, Yankton's Michael Frick shot 85 to tie for eighth. Yankton's Jimmie Cunningham shot 51 for nine holes to tie for fifth in the boys' 11-under division.

**Minn. All-Star Joe Mauer Welcomes Twins, Er, twins**

ANAHEIM, Calif. (AP) — If there is something Joe Mauer knows well, it's twins.

The Minnesota Twins catcher welcomed twin girls this week, the first children for he and wife Maddie.

Mauer left the team before Tuesday night's game against the Angels to fly home to Minnesota. He made it in time for the birth of Emily and Maren early Wednesday, according to Twins director of baseball communications and player relations Dustin Morse.

Mauer was placed on the paternity leave list before Wednesday's game. Catcher Drew Butera was recalled from Triple-A Rochester.

Butera, who spent the last three years as Mauer's backup, has been with Rochester all season, batting .215 in 79 at-bats after recovering from a broken left hand. Mauer, a six-time All-Star, played in 92 of the first 96 games until Tuesday.

**Miller Returning To Grizzlies**

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) — Mike Miller is going back to a former home, agreeing to a deal with the

Memphis Grizzlies.

Miller confirmed the deal to The Associated Press on Wednesday, about a week after the Miami Heat designated him as their amnesty player after three seasons with the team. Miller will still collect more than \$12 million in salary from the Heat over the next two seasons, but will not count against their salary cap or luxury tax.

The Grizzlies have not yet formally announced the deal.

Miller spent parts of six seasons with the Grizzlies from 2003 through 2008. He helped the Heat win the past two NBA titles, and has averaged 12.3 points while shooting 41 percent from 3-point range in his 13 NBA seasons.

**Former Creighton Coach 'Red' McManus Dies At 88**

OMAHA, Neb. (AP) — Creighton University says former head basketball coach John "Red" McManus has died.

Creighton sports information director Rob Anderson said Wednesday that McManus passed away Tuesday in Omaha at the age of 88. McManus had been under hospice care.

McManus was an assistant at Iowa when he was selected for Creighton's top spot. McManus led the Bluejays to national prominence during his tenure, 1959-1969, and coached them in two NCAA tournaments. Among his top players were two future NBA members, Paul Silas and Bob Portman.

His career record at Creighton was 138-118. Creighton athletic director Bruce Rasmussen says McManus "will be remembered as one of the greatest Bluejays of all time." Services were pending.
