The regular meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chairman Bruce Jensen at 3:30 PM on Tuesday, July 1, 2014.

Roll Call was taken with the fol-

lowing Commissioners present: Bruce Jensen, John Harper, Allen Sinclair, and Donna Freng, Garry Moore absent. Action 14211C: A motion was

made by Harper and seconded by Freng to approve the meeting agenda. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Action 14212C: A motion was made by Sinclair and seconded by Freng to approve the minutes from the June 17, 2014 Commission meeting. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Budget Hearings: The Board began hearings for the 2015 budget. Advised department heads to budget a maximum three percent increase in wages and a maximum three percent increase in operating expenses for 2015. That recommendation was based on a 1.12 percent increase in Yankton County assessed value; and a 1.40 percent increase in the Consumer Price Index over the past calendar year. Based on state law, those combined figures mean the County General Fund budget can only be increased by 2.52 percent in 2015. The current General Fund budget is \$5,257,587. Increasing that amount by 2.52 percent would allow an increase of \$132,491 for 2015.

Coroner: Arica Nickles presented a proposed 2015 budget of \$44,350; which represents an

increase of \$26,636 over the current year budget of \$17,714. This budget reflects the

increase in professional service & fees in the amount of \$20,500; the cost of one autopsy can

cost \$2,500 - \$3,000, services also includes blood tests, head or chest x-ray or CT scan. Increase in salary; \$9,200 budgeted for 62 deaths and a \$250 monthly pay to the elected Coroner, on a natural death investigation takes an average of three days to complete.

Emergency Management Budget: Emergency Management Director Scherschligt presented a proposed 2015 budget of \$259,678; which represents a .54 percent increase of \$1,396 over the current year EM budget of \$258,282. Scherschligt proposed a 3 percent wage increase, and discussed with the commissioners budgeting \$15,000 for Capital Accumulation for maintenance and

Ambulance Budget: Emergency Medical Services Administrator Steve Hawkins proposed a 2015 budget of \$1,110,853; which represents a 10.82 increase of \$108,424 over his current budget of \$102,429. Hawkins proposed a 3 percent wage increase, also
