

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

YANKTON HIGH SCHOOL

New high school students who were not enrolled in Yankton School District during the 2013-14 school year should report to the Counseling Office to register between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on July 31 or August 1. A parent or guardian should accompany them. All new students must present a certified copy of their birth certificate. Prior to registration, parents are asked to request student records from the previous school attended. If these dates are not convenient, please contact the high school Counseling Office (665-7378) during the week of August 4-8 for an appointment.

YANKTON MIDDLE SCHOOL

New Middle School students who were not enrolled in Yankton School District during the 2013-2014 school year should report to the Counseling Office to register between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 7th. If this date is not convenient, please contact the Middle School for an appointment. All new students must present a certified copy of

YANKTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

Elementary school students who were not enrolled in Yankton School District should register August 4 or 5 from 9:00 a.m. to noon at their respective school building. If unsure of student placement, contact the superintendent's office at 665-3998. All new students must present a certified copy of their birth certificate. Parents of children who will be five vears old by September 1, 2014 but who will not be attending Kindergarten may register for Jr. Kindergarten at Webster School if they have not already done so. Call 665-2484 after July 30.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SCHEDULES

The Yankton School District Administrative Offices are located at 2410 West City Limits Road.

The first day of school for Grades 1-12 is Tuesday, August 19 for a full day. Special Education Preschool, Transition I, Jr. Kindergarten, and Kindergarten classes will begin Wednesday, August 20. Webster Elementary Preschool will begin August 25 or 26, depending upon the class your preschooler will be attending. YANKTON HIGH SCHOOL

9th Grade Orientation - An orientation for ninth grade students and their parents will be held on Tuesday, August 5th. Students will report to their homerooms at 7:00 p.m. Staff will be available to help students find their homerooms. A presentation for parents will be held in the YHS main theatre from 7:00-7:45 p.m. The student orientation and parent presentation will both run from 7:00-7:45 n.m. A letter pertaining to other school information will be sent out prior to August 5th. Ninth grade schedules will be distributed in homerooms during Orientation on August 5th. All 9th grade parents are encouraged to put money into lunch accounts, purchase activity tickets, or pay any fees associated with particular classes from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. on August 5th. Staff will also be available during the entire week of August 11-14 at the Yankton High School Principal's Office from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Counselors will be available for schedule changes for 9th grade August 6-8, 11, 12, and 18.

Students in Grade 10-12 will pick up schedules on August 7 and 8. The schedule is as follows:

- · Grade 12, Thursday, August 7, 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- · Grade 11, Thursday, August 7, 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.
- · Grade 10, Friday, August 8, 9:00 to 11:00 a.m.

Students in Grades 10-12 pay class fees at the time they pick up schedules or the week of August 11-14 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Counselors will be available for schedule changes for 10th-12th grades August 7-8, 11, 12, and 18.

YANKTON MIDDLE SCHOOL

If you are unable to attend your child's scheduled meeting, you will need to stop in the principal's office on August 12th through August 15th to pick up schedules and registration packets. SCHOOL BUS SCHEDULES

Students who live outside of city limits are eligible for bus

service. Students who rode the bus to or from school in 2013-14 or have already signed up for service in 2014-2015 will receive a confirmation letter in the mail the week of August 4 indicating the route number assigned, name of the driver and estimated pick up and drop off times for the new school year. All new families, those that have not previously utilized school bus service or those who do not receive a confirmation letter should contact the Transportation Office for information or to sign up for service at 665-3980. Students are encouraged to ride the bus to school on the first day of school so proper identification can be made for transporting the student home on the correct bus the same evening. The afternoon bus exchange area will be at the Middle School at 2000 Mulberry.

LUNCHBOX DEPOSITS AND ACTIVITY TICKETS

MySchoolBucks or to get more information. There is a transaction fee of \$2 to make electronic meal deposits. School meal deposits can be made and student activity tickets will be sold during registration.

SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS

Any preschool special education student who did not attend the Yankton Public Schools last year and was enrolled in a special education program in another district and plans to enroll this year should contact Kathy Wagner, Director of Student Services, at the Administration Building (2410 West City Limits Road) at 665-3999.

Anyone participating in athletics during the 2014-2015 school year must meet the following criteria before they may begin practice:

1. If a student will be in Grades 8, 9, 11 or 12 and PARTICIPATED in athletics in the 2013-2014 school year, they must fill out and return the Interim Pre-Participation History form to the Middle School Principal's Office or the High School Activities Director's office. No one will be allowed to participate until this is on file. Forms are available at the Middle School Principal's Office or the Yankton High School Activities Office.

2. If the athlete will be in Grades 7 or 10, or has never participated in athletics in the Yankton School District but plan to participate in the 2013-2014 school year, they must:

a. Fill out an Initial Pre-Participation History form: and

b. Have a physical taken at a licensed health care provider of your choice and have them fill out the physical part of the form.

This must be done before any participation begins. Forms are available at the Yankton High School Activities Office or for Middle School students at the YMS Principal's Office. Call the Activities Office at 665-8369 with any questions.
