## Former Creighton Coach Named To Lead WSC Women's Soccer

WAYNE, Neb. — Wayne State College Director of Athletics Mike Powicki announced Monday that Bruce Erickson has been named head women's soccer coach. Erickson will begin his duties immediately and becomes the eighth coach in the program's 19-year history.

Erickson has 22 years of experience as a college coach with the last 16 at Creighton University where he guided the Bluejays women's soccer program to a 163-125-32 record that included a 10-6-2 mark in 2014. Erickson led Creighton to five NCAA Tournament appearances (2002, '04, '05, '07 & '10), five Missouri Valley Conference tournament championships and two Missouri Valley regular season conference titles. Prior to Creighton, Erickson also served six seasons as head men's soccer coach while also serving four years (1995-98) as athletic director at Viterbo University in LaCrosse, Wisconsin.

Wayne State is an NCAA Division II school located in Wayne, Nebraska and competes in the 16-team Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. Erickson inherits a Wildcat program that was 3-14-1 overall in the 2014 season, going 2-13 in NSIC play.

## Neb. Wesleyan Leaving GPAC

SIOUX CITY, Iowa — The Great Plains Athletic Conference announced on Monday that Nebraska Wesleyan University will be leaving the GPAC to join the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, an affiliated conference of NCAA Division III. Their membership in the IIAAC will begin in the 2016-17 school year.

"We were informed by the NWU administration of this decision to change conference affiliation to the Iowa Conference at 9:30am on Monday and prior to that time had no knowledge of their intentions to depart the GPAC," said GPAC Commissioner Corey Westra in a statement on Monday.

"The GPAC member institutions will move forward as leaders in the NIAA and will continue to work diligently, just as we have since our inception in 2000, to offer the best athletic and academic offerings to our more than 5,000 student-athletes," added Westra. "We are a strong conference and have a great group of institutions that will work together as we continue to offer character driven intercollegiate athletics in the NIAA."

NWU's departure will league the GPAC with 11 members, including Mount Marty College in Yankton. The College of Saint Mary, which joins the GPAC in 2015-16, offers only women's programs. Briar Cliff (Iowa), Concordia (Neb.), Dakota Wesleyan, Doane (Neb.), Dordt (Iowa), Hastings (Neb.), Midland (Neb.), Morningside (Iowa) and Northwestern (Iowa) round out the league.

The IIAAC is comprised of Buena Vista, Central, Coe, Dubuque, Loras, Luther, Simpson and Wartburg.
