CHICAGO BOARD OF TRADE

CHICAGO (AP) — Grains futures were mixed Wednesday on the Chicago Board of Trade. Wheat for July delivery rose 9.5 cents to \$4.6125 a bushel, while July corn added 2.5 cents to \$3.5625 a bushel and oats for July delivery fell 4 cents to \$2.70 a bushel. July soybeans jumped 8.25 cents to \$9.5775 a bushel.

Meanwhile, beef and pork futures traded mixed on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. August live cattle edged up 0.57 cent to 89.17 cents a pound; August feeder cattle slipped 0.07 cent to \$1.109 a pound; July lean hogs added 0.78 cent to 80.9 cents a pound; and July pork bellies lost 0.5 cent to 97.5 cents a pound.
