west of Tyndall, a shed was destroyed and irrigation pivots were flipped over.

"There is not a street around town without either branches or full trees blown down," said area resident Ang Pechous. "I think everyone was very fortunate that there was not more damage from the winds."

Dangel said it was somewhat strange for those kinds of conditions to occur so long after the storm front had passed.

"There really wasn't anything on the radar to indicate we'd be getting that kind of heavy wind," he said. "We're waiting back on the official verdict from the National Weather Service as to what they want to call it, but it sure looks to me that it was a microburst."

A microburst is a column of sinking air that can produce divergent and straight-line winds on the ground.

Vavruska said power was lost in Springfield and Avon at 10 p.m. and was restored at 4 a.m. Wednesday. However, by early Wednesday afternoon some residences were still awaiting the return of their power supplies.

A large amount of moisture accompanied the storm. Yankton had 1.60 inches of rain recorded on its northern limits. Vermillion had 1.65 inches and Tyndall had about three inches.

According to Knox County (Neb.) Emergency Manager Laura Hintz, there
