CHICAGO (AP) — Grains futures were mostly lower Friday on the Chicago Board of Trade.
 Wheat for September delivery lost 6.5 cents to \$4.71 a bushel, while September corn fell 4.25 cents to \$3.495 a bushel and oats for July delivery dropped 10.5 cents to \$2.64 a bushel. November soybeans were unchanged at \$9.12 a bushel.
 Meanwhile, beef and pork futures traded higher on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.
 August live cattle inched up 0.22 cent to \$9.37 cents a pound; August feeder cattle rose 0.53 cent to \$1.132 a pound; August lean hogs added 0.67 cent to 83.92 cents a pound; and July pork bellies gained 1.1 cents to \$1.01 a pound.
