Two oboes, bassoon, voice and keyboard will be featured in two recitals at Trinity Lutheran Church over Father's Day weekend. The first is at 7:30 p.m. Friday, June 17, and the second is at 2 p.m. Sunday, June 19.

Oboist Mark Ackerman, principal oboe with the San Antonio symphony, will be heard a second time at Trinity. He appeared in recital here in June 2009. Ackerman is an active chamber music player and is the artistic director of the Olmos Ensemble.

He will be joined by oboist Mason Tran of Canton and Mindy Braithwaite of Sioux Falls. Tran, a voice actor, was featured oboe soloist with the South Dakota All-State Choir in 2009

and enjoys freelance playing opportunities. Braithwaite is a member of the South Dakota Symphony, the Northwest Iowa Symphony, the Augustana Community Orchestra and the Dakota Wind Ensemble.

Vocalist for the two recitals is Yankton native Solveig Nyberg of Portland, Ore. Nyberg teaches voice and is choir director at Mount Hood Community College in Portland; she has sung with the Dale Warland Singers in Minneapolis and the Bach Festival in Eugene, Ore.

Dr. James and Marilyn Nyberg will be accompanists for the festival, utilizing both Trinity's pipe organ and its new seven-foot

grand piano. Jim is a retired dentist and avid amateur pianist; Marilyn has been organist at Trinity since 1966 and is a teacher of organ. Both are active piano teachers.

Compositions by Clara Schumann, J.S. Bach, G.F. Handel, Kurt Weill, Francis Poulenc and Kenneth Fuchs will be heard in the two recitals.

Trinity Church is located near Fourth and Broadway in Yankton There will be a reception following Sunday's recital. The two admission-free recitals will feature different programs.
