Two oboes, bassoon, voice and keyboard will be featured in two recitals at Trinity Lutheran Church over Father's Day weekend. Dr. James and Marilyn Nyberg will be accompanists for the festival, utilizing both Trinity's pipe organ and its new seven-foot grand piano. Jim is a retired dentist and avid amateur pianist; Marilyn has been organist at Trinity since 1966 and is a teacher of organ. Both are active piano teachers.

Trinity is located at 4th and Broadway in Yankton. There will be a reception following Sunday's recital. Since the two admission-free recitals feature different programs, plan to attend both.
