speaker and a centennial video tribute to the school. For banquet tickets, stop at the St. Rose Church rectory or contact (402) 388-4814.

St. Rose School serves an important ministry, said Father Schmitz. "It passes the Catholic faith down through the generations," he said.

Celebrating a centennial "proves that the parishioners of St. Rose are truly dedicated to the Catholic faith through the many sacrifices over the years," he added.

While the centennial reflects on the past, Becker said the future looks bright. "Over the past couple of years, there have been numerous improvements made to our structures on St. Rose campus," he said.

The lower grade building has seen new lights, carpeting, painting, chairs, cabinets, a fresh coat of paint and smart boards. The 1911 building has received new flooring, carpeting, and painting, as well as new computers in the computer lab and thousands of new library books.

The Education Center (convent) has seen new carpet, light fixtures, and paint as well.

The school families and parishioners have received an early birthday gift, Becker said. The parish and school campus earned a listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The 1911 school building and the 1952 church serve as the centerpiece historic structures.

St. Rose School continues to use the 1911 building for grades 5-8, library and computer center.

In the late 1950s and early 1960s, the parish added a more modern architecture styled brick church, which replaced a former wooden church. With growing enrollment, a compatible new brick school was dedicated in 1961, now housing grades 1-4.

Pre-school classes are held in the religious education center, which previously served as the convent.

"Historically, the decision to build a substantial brick school building before a brick church shows how highly the parish regards education," said Jessie Nunn, National Register Coordinator for the Nebraska State Historical Society.

"I would say it is rare for any school — parochial, private or public — to still be using its original building."

Nunn noted the different structures incorporated into the St. Rose buildings.

"The contrast between Revivalist architecture of the school and Modern architecture of the classroom building, rectory, and convent is particularly interesting, especially because the church so successfully straddles the divide between traditional and modern," she said.

"Also, the two architects connected to the complex (William L. Steele designed the school and James E. Loftus the other buildings) are very prominent figures in Catholic architecture."

John Van Heek, who served as a volunteer during the National Register application process, called the school structure "a unique gem."

St. Rose School has done a great deal for the community in educating students so well in religion and in all subjects, Van Heek said.

"Religion builds character," he said. "And character is the key to a good education."


The placement of the entire St. Rose complex on the National Register shows a special commitment, Nunn said.

"When looking at Nebraska's historic buildings as a whole, only a small percentage are considered eligible for the recognition St. Rose of Lima has just received," she said.

"It takes dedication just to maintain a building enough to keep it functional. Ensuring that a whole group of buildings retain their historic character is even more impressive."

"The National Register listing is a testament to the St. Rose of Lima community's respect for the past and investment in the future."
