

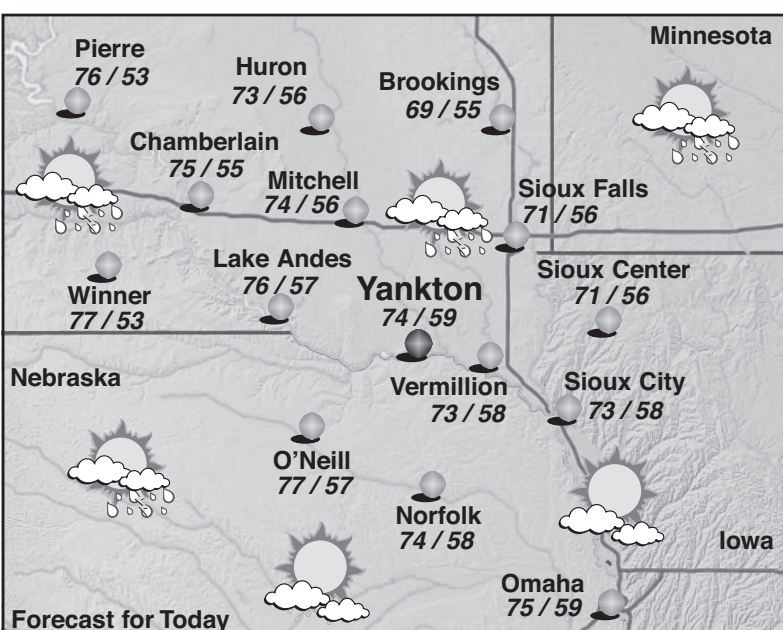
Yankton's Forecast
