- 75 YEARS AGO Friday, June 17, 1938 A meeting of the county Democratic committee was held here at the court house Tuesday afternoon. A resolution was passed asking that the distribution of grasshopper bait be made a W.P.A. project in this county and a copy was sent to the director and the county commissioners asking that action be taken immediately. Guy Wakefield was a victim of an accident occurring when he tried to fix a spray gun he was using in spraying potato bugs. As he tried to loosen the cap, the gun exploded and forced the cap off, hitting Mr. Wakefield between the eyes. He was taken to Dr. Arthur Smith where four stitches had to be taken in a cut along the length of his eye and nose.
