"Airports get pretty repetitive," he said after telling me he was in Portland, awaiting a flight out of the City of Roses.

The future for Iverson, a Yankton native, is looking rather rosey these days. The 7-foot center is projected by many websites to be selected in the June 27 NBA Draft, although he tries to remain humble about that po-

tential.

Iverson has already visited 14 NBA teams, including Monday's workout with the Portland Trail Blazers, and he is scheduled to work out for three more by the end of the week.

Such is life for a professional prospect. Iverson goes from airport to hotel to meetings back to airports, and then it's off to a new city for the same cycle. Though you might imagine he's getting road weary or homesick, Iverson was clear Monday that, no, don't worry, he's loving it.

"I'm definitely taking full advantage of it," he said.

If nothing else, it's good practice for if he does get drafted next week. As an NBA player, he would constantly be traveling; always moving from one city to the next.

Whatever happens for him next week, Iverson has a whole community rooting for him.
