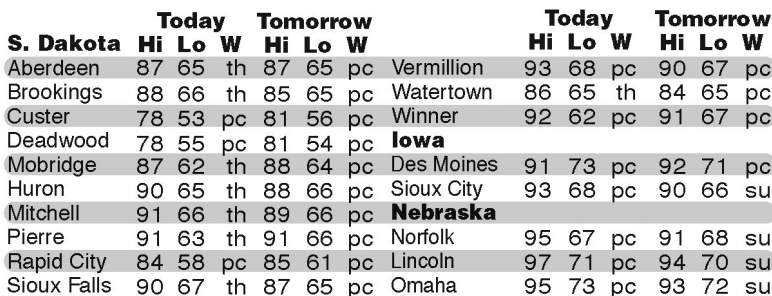


## National Forecast

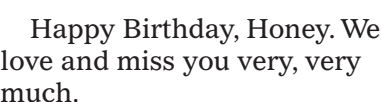
