

NAIA Women's Basketball To Stay In rors 1-3, Larry's Heating & Cooling 0-4 Sioux City Through 2017

YANKTON CHARITY INV. SIOUX CITY, Iowa — The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) announced Monday a contract extension with the Sioux City Convention and Tourism Bureau to host the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball National Championship through the 2017 event. The three-year extension will have Sioux City host the event at the Tyson Events Center/Gateway Arena for 20-consecutive years. The current contract with Sioux City is through the 2014 event. Sioux City has hosted the championship since 1998 with the first six years being held in the Sioux City Auditorium. Since 2004, the championship has been held in the Tyson Events Center/Gateway Arena The 2014 championship, which marks the 23rd annual overall event, will be contested March 12-18 in the 10.000-seat Gateway Arena. The 32-team field is comprised of automatic qualifiers from NAIA affiliated conferences and association of independents, plus at-large selections, which will be determined using the final Coaches' Top 25 rating. Eight games will be played on each of the first three days, with the quarterfinals set for March 15, the semifinals on March 17 and the NAIA National Championship final on March 18.


