take a lot of time learning about how robots think and then how they take information they're given to move and function."

The 12 robots will look and be programmed similarly, but Siebrandt will provide kids the opportunity to perform unique actions to solve challenges and complete obstacles.

"How they get their robot to complete a challenge is up to them and their own creativity," she said. "I'm not going to give them specific instructions every time, but instead let them use their creativity to get their robot to do what it needs to."

This new class is offered to 24 kids, 8 and older, free of charge because she received a grant from the Yankton Area Foundation of the South Dakota Community Foundation for \$3,000 and about \$1,600 from the Yankton County 4-H Foundation to cover the \$4,600 needed to purchase the kits.

She plans to put the awarded funding to use by continuing

with the limitless construction and programming options one kit provides. She hopes to instruct robotics classes in cooperation with schools and other youth serving organizations in the area and offer advanced classes in future years to youth interested in building on skills learned at the beginner's class.

"This six-week class is just a start," she said. "We're building this first robot now, but we can come back a year later and build a totally different one that does different things."

"Youth thrive when you give them a challenge and don't set exact perimeters of how to complete the challenge," she said. "Today, our world is limitless, and I want to encourage the kids to use their imagination and think outside of the box. I really hope that the class gives kids confidence to see and understand that they can really do anything."

Robotics classes are held Thursdays at the Yankton Community Library from 1-2:30 p.m. Classes begin Thursday, June 11, and conclude Thursday, July 16.
