Miles Claims Second At U.S. Indoor T&F Championships
ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — South Dakota's Derek Miles cleared 18-8 1/4 to finish second in the men's pole vault during the 2010 USA Indoor Track and Field Championships at the Albuquerque Convention Center over the weekend.
Miles, an assistant track coach at the University of South Dakota, made four of the first seven attempts and finished with the same height as Tim Mack, but more misses down the stretch by Miles gave Mack the victory.
The performance qualified Miles for the IAAF World Indoor Championships, which will be held March 12-14 in Doha, Qatar.

Cain Earns Great West Honor
VERMILION — University of South Dakota men's basketball forward Tyler Cain has been selected the Great West Conference Player of the Week, the league announced Monday. This is the second weekly honor this season for Cain, who was also named the GWC Student-Athlete of the Month for December.
A native of Rochester, Minn., Cain posted two double-doubles in a pair of GWC road victories last weekend. On Thursday against NJIT, Cain scored 20 points and pulled down 13 rebounds to lead the Coyotes to a 68-58 win over the Highlanders. He scored 16 points and 10 rebounds in the second half. He followed with 19 points and 13 rebounds in a 77-73 victory at Chicago State on Saturday.
His 13 boards moved him to 1,013 in his career, as he became the second player in USD men's basketball history with more than 1,000 career rebounds.
