YANKTON COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING
February 17th, 2010

The regular meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chairman Bruce Jensen at 4:30 PM on Tuesday, February 17th, 2010.

Roll Call was taken with the following Commissioners present: Donna Freng, Bruce Jensen, Mark Johnson, Allen Sinclair, Commissioner Tamisea was absent.

Action 1056C: A motion was made by Sinclair and seconded by Johnson to set the agenda as distributed.

Voting Aye: All Nay: None Motion carried.

Action 1057C: A motion was made by Freng and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the February 2nd meeting of the Board.

The ambulance report for the month of January 2010 was presented by Steve Hawkins. The department responded to 136 calls in December with 106 1st calls, 23 2nd/3rd calls, 1 standby and 10 transfers and 6 Commands/supervisor responses. \$89,462 was billed out in January and \$34,701 was received in January. \$44,770 was expended in January and \$34,701 was received in January.
