"The good part of that is he didn't get any special treatment because he happened to be an elected official, but the bad part is he needed it. And there ultimately were other options," he said.

Smith said the supporters of the bill also use misleading information, such as when they say the American Medical Association supports the bill.

The AMA announced its support, Smith said, because of a "doc fix" that would

bill deliberately so they could say, 'Well, it's paid for," Smith said. "(Including it) would have made the health care bill not paid for. ... It's those kinds of numbers games that create division.
