

tals in the lead-up to a NATO summit meeting in Chicago in May.

President Barack Obama called Karzai on Friday seeking clarification on the demand concerning U.S. troops in rural areas, and White House press secretary Jay Carney said the leaders agreed to keep discussing the matter, which is at the heart of the military strategy.

"I think that the two men were very much on the same page" about gradually handing over security responsibility to Afghan forces, with U.S. and other international troops switching to a support role throughout Afghanistan sometime in 2013, Carney said. A final transition to Afghan control is supposed to happen by the end of 2014.

Another pillar of the war strategy is creating meaningful peace talks with the Taliban insurgents, but that, too, suffered cracks in the aftermath of the village massacre. The Taliban said it was no longer talking on terms set by the Americans.

and then the RiverWalk committee adds up the scores and ranks them," Scheve said. "We really try and let the art speak for itself."

Two additional RiverWalk locations will be added this year. The first will be in the parking lot area near the Meridian Bridge, and the second will be on the one corner of the Third Street and Cedar Street intersection that doesn't already have a pedestal.

Scheve said she is proud that RiverWalk is entering its third year.

"This board has worked very hard over the last four years to get to where we are today," she stated. "We started this project in 2008 at the beginning of a recession, which is not an easy time to start a 501(c)(3). We have continued to successfully jump over every hurdle in the process and have been able to expand each year and

"The community has embraced this project, and I truly believe it is a great asset for the downtown area, especially with the Meridian Bridge conversion completed," Scheve added.

Hanna Sitting Crow, the executive director of Historic Downtown Yankton, reinforced those thoughts.

"The sculptures are a fabulous enhancement to downtown Yankton," she said. "We appreciate all the work the RiverWalk group has done. We see people looking at the statues on a regular basis and being enjoyed by visitors and business owners.

Those looking at RiverWalk can now use a mobile phone application to enhance the experience. By searching for "Yankton RiverWalk" the free application can be downloaded at Apple's iTunes store or the Droid Marketplace.

"It is a free app that has all of this year's sculptures on it," Scheve said. "App users can read the artist statement for each sculpture, use the map to find the sculptures and then also vote for their favorite. The map is a fun feature, because it pulls up all of the sculptures closest to you."

Observers can also vote for their favorite sculpture at www.yanktonriverwalk.org.

In May, the committee will hold an artist celebration to recognize the artists from the current season, as well as the incoming artists.

"The event will be built around celebrating their work and is an opportunity for the public to ask them questions about pieces they have submitted but also to learn more about the artist and their repertoire," Scheve said. "There will be a silent and a live auction, and the public will have the opportunity to purchase a sculpture at that

The committee is looking forward to getting public feedback on the new season of sculptures.

"We are excited for the future and to see how this project can evolve and expand and continue to be a cornerstone, or pedestal if you will, in the downtown area," Scheve said.


