Jeb Bush: No Citizenship Path For Illegal

WASHINGTON (AP) Former Florida Gov. Jeb Bush writes in a new book that the nation needs to completely overhaul its immigration policies but cautions against providing a pathway to citizenship for illegal immigrants, a position that puts him at odds with some Senate reformers

In "Immigration Wars: the nation and members of his Republican party, calling fellow Republicans "remarkcomes to courting Hispanic voters — to the extent they GOP fails to change, he says the influence of Hispanic voters "will doom" the

party's future. The son and brother of U.S. presidents writes that lawmakers should create a path to legal status for undocumented immigrants who live in the U.S. and agree to plead guilty to a crime of illegal entry. But unlike a bipartisan Senate proposal pushed by fellow Florida Republican Marco Rubio and others, Bush says tougher border security should not be a prerequisite and a pathway to legal status should not include citizenship for those who entered illegally as

One of the festival's judges, Mount Marty College Director of Theatre Andy Henrickson, was so impressed by the Menno entry that he invited the students to perform the play at MMC. That performance will take place at 7 p.m. tonight (Tuesday) at the college's Marian Auditorium.

"What a talented group of young actors," Henrickson said in a news release. "I encourage everyone to come up to the 45-minute performance to see what a great job they do with a very challenging topic."

In the Alan Haehnel play, Nora, suffering from Alzheimer's disease, follows the vision of her late husband into the woods on a cold night. Her life flashes before her, showing her time as an English teacher, a caring wife and a loving mother. Interspersed throughout the play are poems that Nora and her students studied. The poems are symbolic of parts of Nora's life, including her battle with disease, losing her son in Vietnam and the loneliness felt by her daughter.

'There's war, Alzheimer's, mother-daughter relationships and conflict," Knodel said. "It's a lot of things to deal with in a short period of

Under the rules for the one-act play, the students have only 45 minutes to set up, perform and remove everything from the stage.

Along with the moving performance by Menno at the state festival, Henrickson said what stood out to him was how many students are involved in the play. Out of 66 students who attend Menno High School, 39 are cast and crew members. "This speaks so strongly

of the support of the arts activities at Menno High School," Henrickson said. "In fact, the critique in Brandon was standing room only the town must have closed everything down for the morning.

for the school's program goes back several years.

The kids at Menno absolutely love drama," she said. "I think it has a lot to do with how we teach them. We try to keep everything pretty positive and uplifting with the kids. I think by doing that, we get them to come
