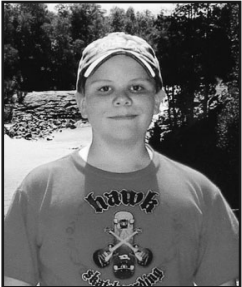
Gracie Brockmeier

Favorite School Memory(s): My 4th grade field trip to the health fair.



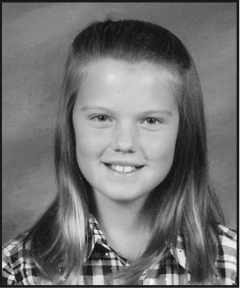
Kelsie Faulk

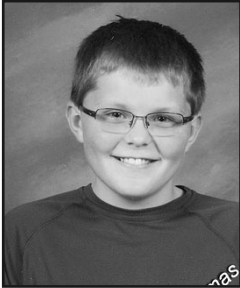
Sam Herrboldt

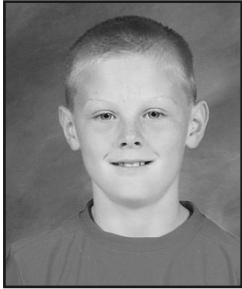

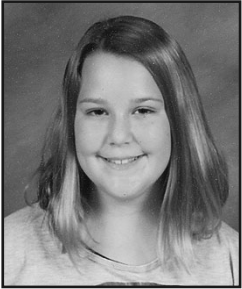

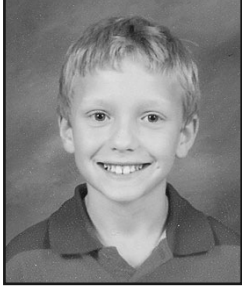
