House bill would not allow local control, while a Senate bill would.

"The states gave authority to the federal government, and whatever they didn't give to the federal government, they reserved to themselves," Stevens said. "Municipalities don't have the authority to enact texting bans. That's left up to the state."

Rep. Hunhoff said he is willing to allow local control. "I like the idea that all our

cities, counties and schools experiment with different ways to do things," he stated.

On another subject, Rep. Hunhoff expressed frustration with the plan for funding the Building South Dakota Fund. The Senate has approved Daugaard's plan to use \$30 million from unclaimed bank accounts and other assets to finance the fund, which provides loans and grants for housing, workforce education and infrastructure that supports development projects. The unclaimed property money will finance the development fund for three years. After that, another bill passed by the Senate would use surplus state revenue to support the fund.

"It's very disappointing that it passed the Senate," Rep. Hunhoff said. "I think there will be a good effort to try to do a better job of reforming the governor's package on the House side. The governor is proposing to take away the funding source and give the program scraps of the budget. If there are any scraps left over, then the program gets those scraps.'

Sen. Hunhoff disagreed with that characterization of the

plan. "The allocation is still there. It's consistent. And it's actually redirecting additional resources to Building South Dakota," she said. "I don't see it as taking away. I see it as making sure we can afford to do that (while making sure the state is fiscally sound)."

Also Saturday: all three legislators say they support a 3.8 percent increase in education that would restore per-student spending to where it was before 2011 budget cuts;

• Rep. Hunhoff said he has not fully made up his mind on running for re-election but is leaning toward running for the District 18 Senate seat. Sen. Hunhoff and Stevens have said they will run for the two House seats.
