It's Exciting To See Young Programs Like GV Break New Ground

Nothing is as exciting as watching an athlete or team accomplish something that they've never done before. When you see a team do something that they — or anyone ever from their school — has ever done before, and do it in front of a huge crowd in an exciting game, then you've got some excitement. The Gayville-Volin girls did just that on Thursday night, when they won the Region 5B championship in a 44-40 overtime win over Freeman at the Summit Center. Gayville-Volin had never even sniffed success on the hardwood before. No Raider team had even won a district title before the GV girls upended top-seeded Viborg-Hurley and second-seeded Alcester-Hudson on the way to the District 10B crown last week. The squad is made up as many Class B programs are, loaded with multi-sport athletes. The same girls that cut down the nets at the Summit Thursday night were hitting the ball over the net for a 21-4

volleyball team or were running the trails for the Class B runner-up cross country team. (Some did both.) Most will be competing in track and field, playing golf or both for the Raiders this spring. The lessons learned from those successes played a part in what the Raiders were able to accomplish this winter. The team improved as the season progressed, running off six straight victories at one point during the season, and avenged double-digit losses to Viborg-Hurley and Alcester-Hudson in the districts. Even Thursday's game provided some learning points, as the Raiders built a lead, saw it slip away, then made plays down the stretch in both regulation and overtime to take home the victory. And it would be hard to believe that next Thursday's noon matchup with top-seeded Sully Buttes in Huron Arena could get any louder than the Summit Center was for the regional final. No matter the outcome at state, the experience will be the next step in the growth of the Gayville-Volin girls' basketball program. And, while their district and region have some other good young teams as well, it would not be hard to believe that this will be the first of several state tournament appearances for these young ladies.
