Fermenting Faith To Explore Links Between Christianity, Buddhism

Can a person be both a Christian and a Buddhist? The short answer is "Yes." The public is cordially invited to explore possibilities of transformation and enlightenment.

Fermenting Faith is offering a free and open to the public program on March 29 (9 a.m.-noon) at Christ Episcopal Church, 517 Douglas Ave., Yankton. This event will be facilitated by the Rev. James Pearson and Dr. Michael McVay.

The central figure in Christianity is Jesus Christ. Christians know the stories of his life, death and resurrection. He also taught about how to live a life filled with compassion and love. The Buddha lived in India 500 years before Jesus and became a great spiritual teacher as well, yet few in the Christian West are familiar with his teachings and the "spiritual landscape" that Jesus and the Buddha both inhabit.

Jesus and Buddha were teachers of wisdom that undermined and challenged conventional ways of seeing and being in their time and for every time. Their teachings are paths to awakening and transformation.

March 29's opening session will include a video presentation by James Finley PhD who was a Trappist monk and was mentored by Thomas Merton, author and 20th century Christian mystic. Participants will be given an overview of the life of the Buddha and several of his essential teachings.

There will be time for discussion and the morning will conclude with a brief meditation.

In 2011, he was awarded an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters from St. Francis University in Loretto, Pa. Prior to joining CCUSA, Snyder served as executive director of Catholic Charities of St. Paul and Minneapolis, the largest private provider of social services in the Twin Cities.

In his March 20 presentation, Snyder will begin with a broad perspective of poverty before focusing on the issue of hunger. He will also speak on the responsibility we have as a community of faith to take action.
