"Some of us are going to be beaten down severely and we have to decide whether we're going to get up and fight," he said. "With the Lord's help with everything from the Lord, not just His help — everyone has a chance to make it."

Despite never having coached in a major program, Meyer still had an impact on some of the game's biggest names, including former Tennessee Volunteers women's basketball coach Pat Summitt.

"He taught me how to teach others how to play the game," Summitt said in an interview with ESPN in 2009. "When I started coaching at Tennessee, I was 22 years old. I had four players (who were) 21 that were seniors. And I never coached a day in my life. So did Coach Meyer help me? Tremendously.

After a 38-year head coaching career with Hamline Uni-

versity (1972-1975), Lipscomb University (1975-1999) and NSU (1999-2010), Meyer retired with 923 wins. In collegiate basketball, this makes him sixth all-time in wins behind Harry Staham (1,077, McKendree University), Danny Miles (1,004, Oregon Institute of Technology), Herb Magee (98, Philadelphia University), Mike Krzyzewski (983, Army, Duke University) and Jim Boeheim (947, Syracuse University). At the time of his retirement, he was the all-time winningest coach in men's basketball history.

At the 2009 EŠPYs, Meyer received the Jimmy V Award For Perseverance. Meyer was inducted into the South Dakota Hall of Fame in 2012. Additionally, Meyer coached 22 All-Americans, three national players of the year, 19 national tournament appearances and his 1985-1986 Lipscomb team won the NAIA National Championship.
